# The Opera in Choral Music

Opera, Theatre, Artsong and Oratorio for Children and Youth Choirs The 2004 New Millennium Festival and CME Conducting Institute will feature arias, duets and scenes from Mozart's Magic Flute, the world premiere of American composer Robert Kyr's cantata of psalm texts on musical themes from the Welsh hymn tradition for soprano, choir and chamber orchestra and song scenes from Leonard Bernstein's Peter Pan. The Choral Music Experience Institute is an on-going conducting education program dedicated to the professional development of choral teachers and the music education of children and youth through concert performance. Hosted by the University of Wales Institute at Cardiff, the vibrant and interactive program for singers, choral teachers, conductors and composers will focus on singing and conducting techniques related to the performance of recitative, aria, and chorus in opera and theatre, art songs and oratorio for children and youth choirs.

The historic Llandaff Cathedral will serve as the venue for the CME Institute's conducting masterclasses, concert rehearsals, and Friday's Invitational Community Concert. A wonderfully evocative building, its foundation dates back to 1120 AD. Completed in 1280 - Llandaff offers superb acoustics and a peerless venue to engage in collaborative music-making.

Cardiff, the capital and chief port of Wales, has an ancient history. The ruins of Cardiff Castle, built in 1090 AD on the site of a Roman Fort, are only one example of this historical continuum. It is a vibrant city, steeped in the history and cultural traditions of the Welsh people – a "bardic nation" who have seen themselves both as distinct from, and a "cultural elite" as compared to the rest of the United Kingdom. The Welsh passion for music, and the extent to which that musical spirit infuses their culture, characterizes both Cardiff and the Welsh selfidentity.
